Noel Maldonado, Hiring Manager and Supervisor of the Loading Dock, has hired more than 20 individuals from CEO since 2007. “With responsibility for TV Shows like “Law & Order: C.I.” and “The Sopranos,” as well as handling Fashion Week for companies such as Victoria’s Secret and on-location shoots for Vogue Magazine, our loading dock is a very busy place. We have a vast inventory and when the loading dock is overwhelmed I hire temporary workers from CEO -- workers I can count on because they’ve been pre-screened -- generally for two-to- three month stints. When permanent jobs have opened up, I’ve been able to move several of the outstanding CEO workers into those jobs, and it’s been my pleasure to do so. Some of them have been promoted to supervisory positions and they are flourishing.”
